Mitigation Specialist

The Office of the Federal Defender for the Eastern District of Missouri has an opening for a **Mitigation Specialist**. The office operates under authority of the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, to provide services of the highest quality to indigent persons in federal criminal cases. The main office is located in Saint Louis, Missouri with a branch office in Cape Girardeau, Missouri. This is a full-time position with a focus on the Saint Louis office and some work assisting attorneys in Cape Girardeau.

Master's Degree in Social Work preferred. At least two years of experience in the investigation and development of mitigation evidence *or* employment in the social work field is preferred as is a working knowledge of the court system. Excellent investigative, interviewing and writing skills required. Experience in videography and/or fluency in Spanish are pluses.

The Mitigation Specialist will gather and summarize records and conduct interviews to create client social histories. They will use this information to develop mitigation themes and work with attorneys to analyze and present this information on the client's behalf. The position involves consulting with experts, managing relationships with clients and their families, as well as maintaining contacts with local social service providers to connect clients with needed services and assist with client advocacy.

This is a full-time position with federal salary and benefits based on qualifications and experience. Salary is on a scale equivalent to that of Assistant United States Attorney's Office. This position is subject to mandatory electronic transfer (direct deposit) participation for payment of net pay. Current and future positions may be filled from this vacancy announcement. This position is subject to funding and background check. This is an at will appointment and as such may be terminated at will or without cause by the Defender at any time.
